



Barrington Community Garden

General Rules

- The BCG is open from dawn until dusk, seven days a week. Please park only in the designated parking area in front of the garden. Do not park in or along the driveway.
- Children are welcome in the BCG, under adult supervision. Pets are not allowed in the BCG.
- Water is available from spigots installed throughout the garden. Spigots should be turned on/off by the metal wheel handle ONLY; please do not use/reposition the red plastic valve on the riser pipe.
- Community tools are available in the shed; please clean and return these tools to the shed after use.
- Use of hoses is permitted; however, please take care not to disturb/damage other garden plots or pathways.
- All personal tools and supplies must be stored within the boundaries of the leased plot. The shed is not to be used for storing personal items.
- Lessees are welcome to harvest herbs from the Community Herb Garden and raspberries from the raspberry patch.
- BCG maintains a “trash in, trash out” policy; please keep the BCG tidy.
- The Town of Barrington shall not be liable for any injury to persons or property resulting from community gardening or other on-site activities. Participation is at the Lessee’s own risk.
