



Barrington Community Garden 2017 Community Work Dates and Responsibilities (Revised May 10, 2017)

All lessees are required to participate in four hours of community work for each plot they lease in the care and upkeep of common areas of the garden. This year, we'll be holding community work days on:

- **Wednesday evenings** from 6 pm to sunset on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month, and
- **Saturday mornings** from 9 to 11 am on the first Sunday and third Saturday (sometimes 10am – noon) of each month (see attached calendar).

A Steering Committee member will be present at the garden to sign you in and let you know the tasks to be accomplished. Each session is a “come-as-you-may,” with no prior notification needed. Work can be performed for the full session or in 30-minute increments.

All volunteers must sign in with a Steering Committee member. To help you track your hours, a log of completed community work hours will be posted shortly after each work session on the community message center.

If the times posted above do not work for you or if you have any questions regarding your community work commitment, please contact a Steering Committee Member through the website (www.barringtoncommunitygarden.org). and we will try to accommodate you.

Lessees may pay a fee of \$50 per plot in lieu of the above 4 hours of community work per plot. This option must be selected prior to June 1st of the current season. If a lessee chooses this option, a check for \$50 per leased plot, payable to the Town of Barrington and with BCG- Plot# in the memo section, should be mailed to Barrington Community Garden c/o 48 Townsend Street, Barrington, RI 02806, prior to June 1, 2017.

VERY IMPORTANT: In addition to your four hours of community work per leased plot (or payment in lieu of), you are required to keep the North and East sides of your plot weed-free and well-chipped. This can be done at any time and is best done on a regular basis.
