



## 2018 Barrington Community Garden Plot Closing Instructions

Please note important instructions below.

As part of the BCG lease agreement, lessees have agreed to clean their leased garden plot of all plant debris and other support structures by the garden closing date of **Sunday December 2, 2018**.

Fences surrounding a plot are allowed to remain over the winter. Plots that are not properly cleaned by this date will be considered abandoned and the current lessee will be unable to lease for the 2019 season. Here are important notes:

- All spent plant material must be removed from the plot by **December 2**. Cleaned plots may be mulched with straw, compost, cover crops, or the like for winter protection. If you intend to renew the same plot next year, plants being overwintered for next season (such as garlic) may remain.
- All cages, trellises, and other plant support structures must be removed for the winter. If not removed, these items will be disposed.
- All appropriate spent plant debris (e.g., not diseased or containing seeds) can be placed in the compost bins. Other plant debris must be disposed of in yard waste bags and brought to the very **end** of the driveway along Wampanoag Trail for municipal yard waste pick-up. There are yard waste bags in the shed you can use.
- The shed is for the storage of community tools and TAP-IN-related items only; not for the storage of personal items. All personal items will be removed and disposed.
