

Accessing the *Barrington Community Garden* from Wampanoag Trail, while direct, can be a bit tricky and a little unsafe with merging traffic in the turn-around. We suggest the following as the best route to the *Barrington Community Garden* from anywhere in Barrington.

Using the corner of Middle Highway and Lincoln Avenue as the starting point, proceed north on Middle Highway to the end of the road (you'll enter East Providence and the road will curve and change names – ignore this). At the end of Middle Highway, turn right onto Estrell Drive and proceed less than a mile to Argyle Avenue. Turn right onto Argyle Avenue, which will empty into Wampanoag Trail by the Barrington Medical Center. Turn right onto Wampanoag Trail, and the BCG is just a short distance on your left.

If you are coming from further south, you can reach Middle Highway by taking a left onto Federal Road from County Road at the White Church intersection, proceeding to the end of Federal Road, and making a right onto Middle Highway.

If you are coming from the west, you can reach Middle Highway by proceeding east on either Lincoln Avenue or Old County Road.
