



Accessing the *Barrington Community Garden* from Wampanoag Trail, while direct, can be a bit tricky and a little unsafe with merging traffic in the turn-around. We suggest the following as the best route to the *Barrington Community Garden* from anywhere in Barrington.

Using the **corner of Middle Highway and Lincoln Avenue** as the starting point, proceed **north on Middle Highway** to the end of the road (you'll enter East Providence and the road will curve and change names – ignore this). At the end of Middle Highway, **turn right onto Estrell Drive** and proceed less than a mile to Argyle Avenue. **Turn right onto Argyle Avenue**, which will empty into Wampanoag Trail by the Barrington Medical Center. **Turn right onto Wampanoag Trail**, and the BCG is just a short distance on your left.

If you are coming from further south, you can reach Middle Highway by taking a left onto Federal Road from County Road at the White Church intersection, proceeding to the end of Federal Road, and making a right onto Middle Highway.

If you are coming from the west, you can reach Middle Highway by proceeding east on either Lincoln Avenue or Old County Road.
